

## Matthew 19:14


Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."

Vision Beyond Borders is working to send teams all over the nation to provide Bibles to those that are without the Gospel. We work to rescue women out of trafficking, bring pastors supplies to build their churches, and provide clothing to refugees. God's guidance in our ministry and in the people involved has brought so many to Him and we pray that we continue to see the love for Christ grow in every country.

Our teams are working in the red light district of India to rescue women from sex slavery. One member stated, "Honestly, I have NEVER been so affected by, and had such deep emotions about a trip before. I never wanted to leave." God wrecked the hearts of all those that travelled, but this heartbreak led each one to a deeper awareness of God's own heart, and how deeply He loves His children. These women that work in this red light district are hurting and so desperate for hope, but God has bigger plans than any of us can see. This team was also able to smuggle in around 245 Bibles to a closed SE Asian country, praise the Lord! His Hands are in the darkness even when we cannot see the light.

Our Romania safe house works every day to keep women off of the streets and out of slavery. They encourage a Biblical lifestyle as well as train them for the day they live on their own. Though it is scary to be so close to being thrown out on the streets and into sex trafficking, it is a wonderful experience to feel God pulling you towards him. The biggest blessing to the last team in Romania was that it was so wonderful to be able to share a small amount of work necessary to get this vision up and running and that they could feel God's presence through the whole trip.

God has provided our Pakistan ministry with the hands to distribute tens of thousands of Bibles into the country. His heart for His children is beyond what we can even fathom, and He has called Vision Beyond Borders to open a children's home to take care of them.







There are 1.5 million kids living on the streets in Pakistan today. Over half of these children are runaways forced out of their homes from abuse and living in poverty. The children that are not sold into prostitution make a living by washing cars, shining shoes, or begging for money. Street children are considered the largest social group in this country. They suffer from many illnesses, as they do not have proper health services to tend to their needs. With your help, we can reduce the number of children on the streets while also offering them a loving, safe home where they have the opportunity to grow in Christ and learn basic life skills. These children are in desperate need of love, care, medical attention, and a safe place to call home.

Currently there are more than 20 children eagerly waiting to move in to their new home. Vision Beyond Borders will open the children's home on June 1<sup>st</sup> 2019. The goal of this project is to help those without a father and without a home. It has been placed on our hearts to reach out to these children with open, helping hands to show God's love to them. We want to give them the opportunity to grow in a relationship with Jesus Christ as well as learn their value in Him.

God provides for every person on this earth whether you see it at the moment or not. These children are struggling and lost but God has a greater plan for them. God is providing for these Children and we feel that it is our job to step in and help give them what they need.

Romans 8:38-39 tells us, "For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor ruler, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."
