We are so grateful to the Lord for His faithfulness. Over the past thirty years we have been able to deliver over 2.1 million Bibles to persecuted and poor Christians around the world.

I remember the first Bible I received after I was saved. It was so exciting to hold God's Word in my own hands. Having the opportunity to read God's Word at any time night or day was so encouraging. Now forty years later I'm still so grateful to have the Truth that never changes in these crazy, uncertain times and to know the Creator of the universe through His Word.

Through your prayers and support we are working to provide 500,000 more Spanish Bibles to people in Latin America who don't have the truth of God's Word. I was recently blessed to see a video of a prison in Venezuela where the whole prison yard was filled with prisoners on their faces repenting for their sins and asking God to send a revival to Venezuela. 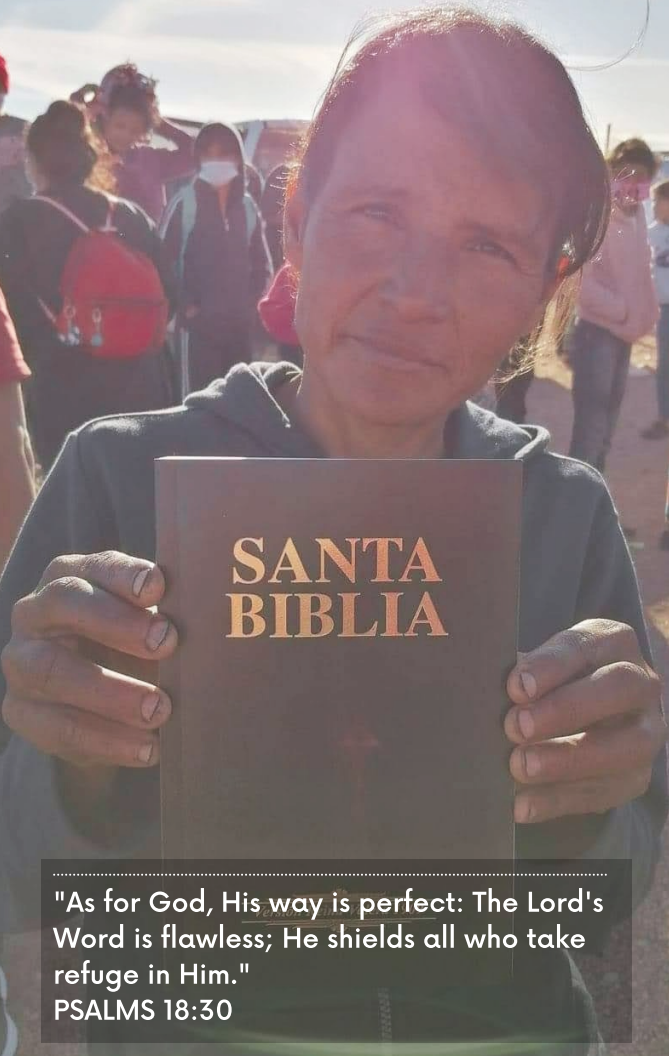

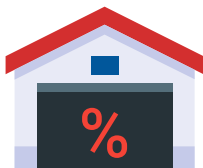


# A STORY FROM **Mexico:**
