

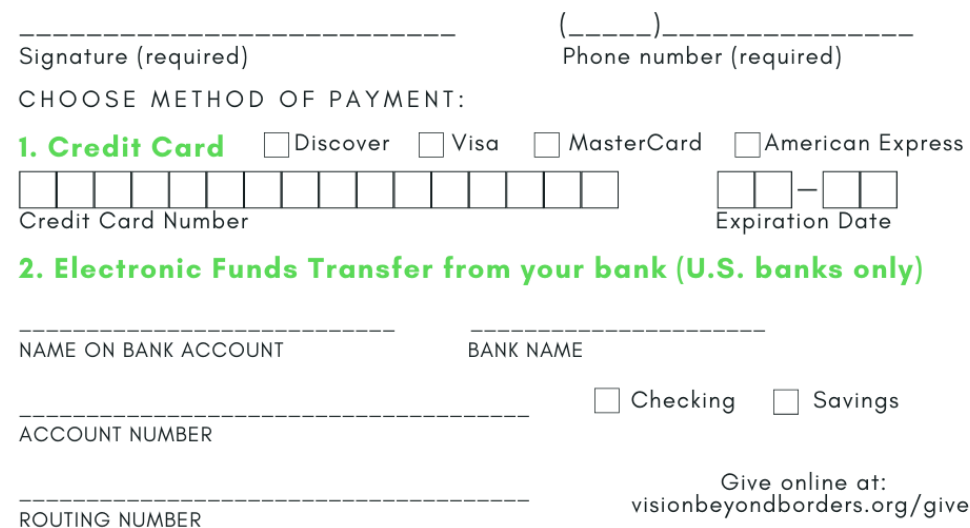

SAFE HAVEN HOME

After learning in September that Safe Haven Children's home would be required to vacate the home they were living in, we joined with them in prayer believing that the Lord would intervene and provide a new space for all of the children and the Munir family. Right before the start of the new year we received great news from Pakistan that a new home had been rented, and a move in date set for early January! While the last year presented many challenges, we are so proud of the faith and perseverance that everyone at Safe Haven Home has shown. We ask that you join us in encouraging them and believing that the best is yet to come! God is opening doors in Pakistan for His word to go out and His love to reach even the children who the world has turned their back on.



Hear from the Munir family...

"Just this week we have received calls about two more families with orphan children. One family is a group of four siblings whose mother and father passed away. We are hoping to bring them to our home when we return to Pakistan. Azeem believes we can have 20 children in the new home. There are 2 large bedrooms downstairs which we plan to use for a girl's room and boy's room. Each has a private attached bath. There is a large double kitchen downstairs and a big eating hall/ classroom. We will continue to look for another home which we can rent to accommodate more children. This is a very difficult task. Azeem looked at over a hundred homes before he found the house we rented. ...only the Lord can make it happen. He speaks the language and is Pakistani but there is so much opposition doing God's work in a hostile environment. It is a miracle we have the house and kids we have. We take one day at a time. We trust that by the Lord's blessing we can continue to work in Pakistan to rescue more children, distribute Bibles and minister to needy people."



"The ultimate goal is to one day purchase land to build a boy's dorm, girl's dorm, church/ school, and have a farm where we can grow our own food. It would be beneficial for the children to be able to run and play outside. It will also be a better situation for privacy of living as foreigners in Pakistan. Azeem says when the Lord provides a large piece of land and buildings we could have 100-200 children. Again this needs lots of prayer. It can only come by God's provision."
