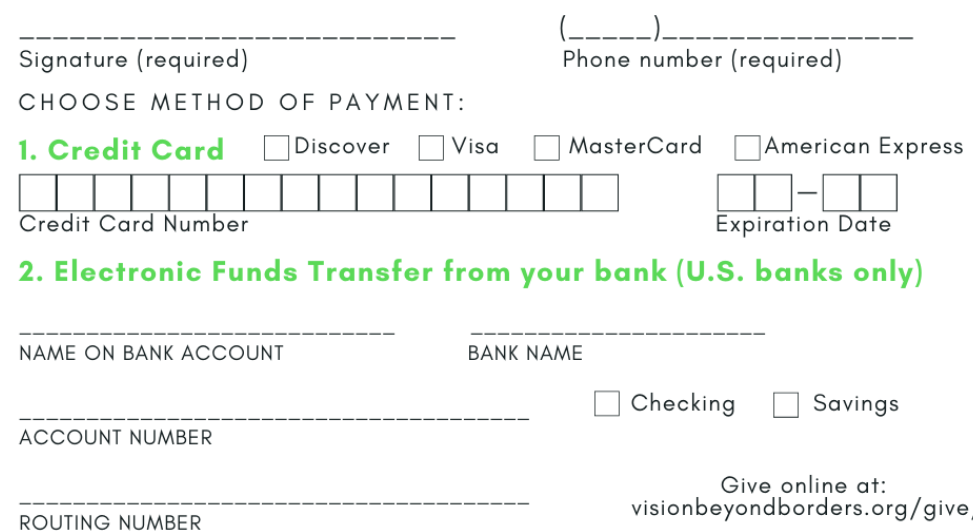

# They Call Me Mother

the story of Miss Emerald

Since the early 1900's Taunggyi Orphanage, also known as Miss Emerald's Home, has been set apart in a primarily Buddhist community as a refuge filled with the love of Christ. Thousands of children have found love within this home, but more importantly, the opportunity to experience a relationship with Jesus for the very first time. At 92 years old, Miss Emerald still gives all she has to lost children in need. She has led generations to Christ through her selflessness and compassion.

Vision Beyond Borders has had the privilege of sponsoring this home, sending teams and providing financial support to ensure the work of the Lord continues there. With the generous support of many people, we were able to secure land for a new building that will house hundreds more children. Unfortunately, the events of the last few years, (COVID and civil conflict following a military coup), have put this project on hold for much longer than expected.

We still believe that the Lord is not done working through Miss Emerald and we continue to pray that He would finish the work that has begun in His timing. As Myanmar is still heavily afflicted by military violence, the home has provided refuge for displaced families who have lost everything from military attacks on civilian homes.

In a time of great need we are thankful for the opportunity to share the story of Miss Emerald with the world on April 22nd. Vision Beyond Borders has worked with several partners to bring this story to life in a new documentary, *They Call Me Mother*. We pray that this documentary will give people a deeper look into the hope that Miss Emerald and her family have offered to thousands of children in the midst of a war-torn country.
