Refugee Relief Effort

Suffering inevitably flows from sin, but through charity, we can love our neighbors, ease their pain, and open hearts to the Gospel.

We are grateful for all the opportunities we are given to serve people around the world, and grateful for all that supporters do to share Christ's love through the ministry of Vision Beyond Borders. Whether large or small, each effort is a blessing to those who receive it.

Our relief efforts have grown in scope and now touch many places around the world, as these examples show:

In **JORDAN**, our partners receive shipping containers with many tons of aid delivered to our warehouses in Billings and Casper by supporters. As they distribute the aid to Syrian and Yemeni refugees, Bibles are also distributed and people who have lost everything are introduced to Jesus and His love for them.



In **BURMA**, rice, medicine and other aid is provided by pastors and missionaries to refugees and to IDPs (internally displaced people), as they flee attacks by the military junta trying to terrorize the populace into subjection and exploit tribal lands.

In **HONDURAS**, impoverished villagers strugaling with the destruction of hurricanes and the economic harm of lockdowns have been provided with donated food and clothing, in conjunction with Bible distribution efforts and evangelism by our partners.

In **UKRAINE**, donations were sent to support vehicle purchases and food and medical supplies; Bible school students took supplies in and brought refugees fleeing the fighting out to safety.



Lord willing we will soon be sending a container to Romania to provide winter clothing and other aid for refugees there.

All of this is possible because of the generosity of you, our supporters. Whether bringing clothes, buying medicine, donating online or traveling with us, everything done to share the love of Christ is having an eternal impact.

In **CUBA**, badly needed medical aid is received with tears by doctors who are often unable to provide even basic treatment. For example, recently a man's foot was badly cut by a propeller as he tried to flee Cuba. As a result he was unable to leave, and his doctor had nothing to treat it with. But because aid from VBB arrived in time, he was able to treat the man and he is now recovering without losing his foot.

In **NEPAL**, VBB provides funds each year for pastors to purchase blankets for the poor. In **MEXICO**, pallets of aid are being taken across the border by partners to minister to those in need. Now as reports of tremendous flooding in **PAKISTAN** emerge, we are working with partners to provide aid and pray for salvation for Pakistani victims.
